Cheri and Mike love living in Wasaga Beach. Cheri tells me "It's about the people and the community. Not to mention the beautiful beach and landscape".


These local business owners also give back. They sponsor the Wasaga Stars, who Mike actually coaches and Cheri has been a trainer for over 10 years.

STICKHANDLING AT HOME **FOR BEGINNERS**

The best hockey players will tell you that off-ice training is equally as important as on-ice training. Stickhandling is an essential skill in the game of ice hockey and dedicating even 10 minutes a day to practice off-ice can help you improve. Over time you might find yourself becoming faster, more accurate, and more consistent when handling the puck on the ice. To practice at home, all you need is your stick, gloves, and a ball. Many sport shops sell balls specifically designed for stickhandling, but you can use golf and tennis balls too. Here are a couple simple stickhandling drills you can start implementing at home.

WARM UP SEQUENCE

For a simple warm up sequence, stand in your normal athletic stance with your feet about shoulder width apart. Start stickhandling and focus on moving the ball a very small distance within the centre of your stance. After about 45 seconds, stickhandle so the distance the ball travels is equal with the width of your stance. After another 45 seconds, bend your knees and stickhandle so the distance the ball travels is well outside of your

AROUND THE WORLD

For this drill, your feet must stay planted and facing in one direction. Start by stickhandling in your athletic stance. You may choose to go left or right first, as you will come back to the centre to reset. As you stickhandle, gradually start progressing towards whichever direction you chose. You will reach a point in which you are stickhandling directly to the side of your body. Once you reach this point, you can reverse the process and return to the middle of your stance. From there you can go towards the other side!

THE FIGURE EIGHT

For this drill, you will have to take your gloves off and lay them on the ground in front of you. You get to decide the distance between them, but shoulder width apart is a great place to start. As the name suggests, the goal of this exercise is to stickhandle your ball in a figure eight using your gloves as a guide. This drill is versatile because you can rotate the figure eight from horizontal to vertical!

Stickhandling can sometimes feel like a chore, but you can take the opportunity to listen to some music and try some new drills. Remember to practice keeping your head up and good luck!

Easter Activities for Young Children

Easter is an incredibly fun holiday; afterall, it involves colourful eggs, fun games, treats, and most importantly, the Easter Bunny. Every year, the Easter Bunny works very hard to deliver goodies to each and every child. That being said, it's very important that you and your children prepare your home ahead of time so the Easter Bunny feels welcome! Here's an idea for a fun activity to get you started that's perfect for younger children.

Plan a day where you can spend time with your kids creating fun Easter decorations. Set up a few stations around your kitchen or dining room. Each station can feature a different decoration. For this activity, useful crafting materials include: colourful pipe cleaners, fuzzy pom poms, glue, markers, paint, googly eyes, construction paper, safety scissors, and anything else you think might be fun to use!

Station #1

Use some old cardboard boxes and cut out large eggs from it. Try using the fuzzy pom poms and glue. The colours of the pom poms against the cardboard will look really cool! If you think your child could benefit from a little guidance, you can always take a black marker and draw outlines onto the egg for them.

Station #2

If you're worried about how messy paint is, try this. Start by having your child or you draw an egg on a piece of white paper with a black marker. Then place different coloured blobs of paint on that paper and slip it into a large plastic bag. Your kids can then use their fingers on the outside of the plastic bag to paint the egg



without any mess! You can take the finished product and leave it to dry somewhere safe afterwards.

You can take this one step further if you'd like to have a bigger picture. For this, you'd have to either have painter's plastic lying around or purchase some. Start by taping the picture onto the table or another flat surface. Then, take the plastic and cut it so that it is smaller than the piece of paper by about a half-inch on each side. Now you can add your blobs of paint! Gently lay the plastic on top of the picture and tape down the sides firmly so that no extra paint escapes. Then the rest is up to your kiddo!

Cranberry Peach Pomegranate Mocktail

A super refreshing mocktail that's nothing short of an explosion of tangy and sweet flavour. It's great alone or mixed with vodka or gin, or you can substitute champagne for the ginger ale for a delicious champagne cocktail.

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup frozen fresh cranberries
- 1 cup frozen fresh peach slices
- 2 cups pomegranate juice
- 1/2 tsp freshly crushed or grated ginger
- 1 litre (3 cans) of dry ginger ale
- 8-12 ice cubes

Directions

- In a blender, combine cranberries, peach slices, pomegranate juice, and ginger. Puree until all pieces are crushed
- 2. Add ice to blender and do several pulse bursts to rough chop the ice cubes.
- Combine blended mixture with ginger ale and stir. Pour into glasses and enjoy!

Ideas for stepping it up a notch

- Serve in sugar-rimmed glasses or flutes
- Garnish with orange, lemon, or lime slices, a few pomegranate arils, or a sprig of fresh mint
